

CROP IRRIGATION SERVICE**(1) APPLICATION**

This rider schedule is applicable to service furnished for the operation of electric motor driven pumps supplying water for the irrigation of farmlands. The pumping unit served hereunder shall be the sole source of artificial water supply for the land to be irrigated and shall not be used as a standby or supplement to any other source of irrigation.

All provisions of Rate Schedule GS shall apply except as specified herein. This rider schedule is not available in combination with any of the Company's other riders. The Fuel Cost Adjustment (FA) and the Supply Cost Adjustment (SA) are still effective in conjunction with this rider.

(2) INTERRUPTION

Service furnished under this schedule shall be "off peak" with respect to the peak load on the Company's electric system. The Company reserves the right to limit service hereunder to such an extent and during such hours as the Company may designate in order to comply with this provision.

(g) Plus 50% of the applicable FRANCHISE FEE for electric service within the incorporated limits of a City which assesses a municipal franchise fee as per LPSC Order No. R-27859. Such portions of the municipal franchise fee shall be added to and separately stated on the monthly electric bill for each applicable Customer located within the incorporated limits of that City.		
(h) Plus the proportionate part of any new tax or increased rate of tax, or governmental imposition (except state, parish, city and special district ad valorem taxes and any income taxes) levied or assessed against the Company or upon its electric business, as the result of any or amended laws that may become effective and operate after January 1, 1986.		

On Peak demand shall include all kW used between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. during each of the calendar months of June, July, August or September.

Peak energy shall include all kWh used during each of the calendar months of June, July, August or September.

Non-peak month energy shall include all kWh used during the other months of the year.

(Continued)**(4) SEASONAL SUSPENSION OF SERVICE**

At the Customer's option, service may be disconnected after regular seasonal operations have been completed and reconnected at no charge before the next season's operations provided the total charges, exclusive of fuel cost, paid by the Customer to the Company in the 12 month period ending with the current month is not less than:

- (a) An amount equal to \$20.00 per horsepower of connected load, or
- (b) The amount specified in any electric service agreement between the Customer and the Company.

If the amount paid by the Customer is less than the minimum billing amount required, the difference between these two amounts will be billed to the Customer when service is suspended.
