

Energy Efficiency Residential Program Overview

- 1. Create Project in P3 (create customer, premise and schedule work)
 - a. Single Family Projects move to work completion pending
 - b. Multi-Family Projects of 19 or fewer premises move to work completion pending
 - c. Multi-Family Projects of 20 or more premises must wait for Pre-Approval
 - d. Income Qualified (IQ) Projects: select form of verification eligibility, move to work completion pending. Multi-Family Projects of 20 or more premises must wait for Pre-Approval
- 2. Project Assessment (Evaluate measures and discuss with Customer)
- 3. Combustion Safety Form (Required if gas appliances are present)
- 4. Hazardous Condition Form (if hazards or pre-existing conditions are present)
- 5. Residential Participant Agreement

Signed before work begins by Project Sponsor and Customer (and subcontractor, if applicable)

6. Complete Field Notes

If direct install measures were performed, the quantity must be recorded in the field notes.

7. Pre & Post Installation Pictures

a. <u>Air Infiltration</u>

Pictures capturing the scope/type of retrofit implemented along with blower door test readings showing pre- and post-retrofit condition of the treated spot such as sealing penetrations and air leakage areas are required

b. Ceiling Insulation

A picture showing the entire attic floor and close-up pictures of a ruler that shows the measurement of the depth of the insulation, and an insulation certificate affixed near the attic entrance.

c. Duct Sealing

Pre-and post-pictures of the work performed such as sealing penetrations of the duct leakage areas and duct blaster readings are required.

- 8. All Bills Paid Affidavit (if a subcontractor was used)
- 9. Residential Participant Agreement

Signed upon completion of work by Project Sponsor and Customer (and subcontractor, if applicable)

10. Residential Weatherization Report

The technician must check off the appropriate boxes in each measure category and fill out any corresponding blanks. The customer must sign an acknowledgment that they received a copy and that they understand what work was completed on their home.

- 12. Final Approval by a Program representative in P3 (upon savings verification)
- 13. Payment (upon Final Approval)
