Get help with your energy bill

Eligible customers can get assistance with their heating and cooling energy costs, including bill payment assistance and/or energy crisis assistance through the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), a federally funded program.

In Louisiana, funds are administered by the Louisiana Housing Corporation (LHC) and distributed by community action agencies throughout the state. Applicants must be responsible for the household energy bill, have an active utility account and may only receive one LIHEAP benefit each season.

Heating Season: Nov. 15 – March 15 Cooling Season: April 1 – Sept. 30

Energy Emergency Deferred Billing Program

Cleco's Energy Emergency Deferred Billing Program allows some customers to defer an excess portion of their bill for several months during an energy emergency declared by the Louisiana Public Service Commission. Customers must meet certain eligibility requirements in order to qualify for the program, and must re-qualify every two years. Cleco presents energy efficiency award to Northlake Behavioral Health System



In February, Cleco presented Northlake Behavioral Health System with a check in the amount of \$71,721.60 for lighting upgrades made through Cleco's Power Wise™ energy efficiency program.
