- 1** Your **Billing Date** and **Account Number** are located at the top of your bill.
- 2** **Rate Code** indicates the classification of customer (residential, commercial, etc.).
- 3** **Read Date** is the date the meter is read for bill calculation.
- 4** **Current Meter Reading** is the reading obtained on the read date.
- 5** **Units Used** is the total amount of electricity used for this billing period.
- 6** **Customer Charge** represents the fixed costs of providing service to each classification of customer (residential, commercial, etc.).
- 7** **Energy Charge** represents the cost of delivering electricity to your physical address.
 - **Summer rate**, effective May through October, increases based on usage.
 - ≤1,000 kWh - \$0.06977 per kWh
 - 1,001-1,500 kWh - 0.08372 per kWh
 - ≥1,501 kWh - \$0.10047 per kWh
 - **Winter rate**, effective November through April, is a flat rate.
 - All kWh - \$0.06977 per kWh
- 8** **Fuel Charge** represents the cost of fuel used to generate power.
- 9** **Environmental Charge** represents the cost of compliance with environmental regulations.
- 10** **Interim Storm Restoration Charge** represents the costs to repair damage and restore power after Hurricanes Laura, Delta and Zeta.
- 11** **TCJA Bill Credit** is a corporate tax rate savings passed on to customers from the U.S. Tax Cuts and Jobs Act.
- 12** **Infrastructure and Incremental Costs Recovery** represents the costs of generation projects, reliability projects and other costs not specifically included in the base rate.
- 13** **Electricity Charges** represents the total charges owed to Cleco.
- 14** **Balance Forward** shows any unpaid balance or credit on your account.
- 15** **Total Due Now** is the amount due if your payment is received on or before the due date.
- 16** **Important Messages** may be added to your bill in this area (messages also may appear on a subsequent page).
- 17** **Monthly Usage Graph and Table** track electric usage and compare the amount of electricity used during the same period from year-to-year and from last month to this month (graph and table also may appear on a subsequent page and may not be included on all customers' bills).

If there is a read code on your bill, please see the codes below for an explanation.

- Blank – Successful Read
- 1 – Estimated
- 2 – Off Service Order Read
- 4 – Meter Exchange Read
