GREEN OPTION CLECO RIDER

(1) AVAILABILITY

This Schedule Green Option Cleco ("GO CLECO Rider") is available to Customers of Cleco Power LLC ("Cleco" or the "Company") to provide Customers with an opportunity to voluntarily subscribe to a renewable energy resource. Customers who take metered electric service and are in good standing with the Company are eligible to participate in this program. If applicable, service to Customers that subscribe to more than 500 kW under this GO CLECO Rider must have an Agreement for Electric Service with the Company or must enter into an amendment to a Customer's existing Agreement for Electric Service.

Availability to eligible Customers is on a first come, first served basis in accordance with the Company's receipt of applications for GO CLECO Rider service. The total amount of Renewable Resource Capacity (as defined in Attachment A hereto) that is available for enrollment is specified in Attachment A hereto. Along with allocations of subscriptions to different customer classes, residential and small general service Customers on the residential service ("RS") and general service ("GS") rate schedules with a maximum demand of 100 kW will be allocated approximately 15% of the Renewable Resource Capacity for this GO CLECO Rider program, with the remaining 85% available to all other non-residential Customers. Additionally, as specified in Attachment A, approximately 10% of the residential/small general service allocation will be reserved for Low-Income Residential Customers.

If, after six months following the effective date of this GO CLECO Rider or a modification to this GO CLECO Rider that expands the Renewable Resource Capacity through the addition of further Renewable Resources (as defined in Attachment A hereto) to Cleco's resource portfolio, any portion of the Renewable Resource Capacity that is not then fully subscribed will be open to subscribers from any qualifying customer class on a first come, first served basis. If the program has a subscription waitlist and additional Renewable Resource Capacity is added to the program, the subscription amounts on the waitlist will be fulfilled first and then the remaining Renewable Resource Capacity will be open to all subscribers from any qualifying customer class on a first come, first served basis.

(2) APPLICATION

This GO CLECO Rider is applicable to all rate schedules for metered service subject to the following limitations. Customers may subscribe in increments of 1 kW. Customers may elect a subscription level representing up to 100% of their previous 12-month total kWh usage. Increases in the number of units subscribed will be limited to once per rolling 12-month period from the anniversary date of program enrollment, and subject to program availability.

For non-residential Customers that have multiple accounts, the subscribed kW assigned to each account shall be included in the Customer's Agreement for Electric Service or in an amendment to the Customer's existing Agreement for Electric Service, as applicable.

(3) CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

The charges calculated under this GO CLECO Rider are subject to change in such an amount as may be approved and/or amended by the Louisiana Public Service Commission ("LPSC"). The Company reserves the right to withdraw this GO CLECO Rider at any time at the Company's discretion.

Low-Income Residential Customer identification will be determined by account holder name shown on the monthly residential electric bill. A Customer must self-certify to confirm his or her eligibility as a Low-Income Residential Customer. The Company may, in its discretion, request proof of eligibility and/or work with agencies that administer the federal Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program ("LIHEAP") to verify a Customer's eligibility. If a Customer has misrepresented his or her eligibility during the self-certification process, the Company may, in its discretion, permanently exclude the Customer from participating in this program.

Final determination as to a Customer's qualifications to receive service under this GO CLECO Rider will be made solely by the Company.

(4) MONTHLY CHARGE

A. In addition to the monthly billing amount under applicable rate schedules, Customer's bill will include an additional amount based on the applicable Subscription Charge option below and the Subscription Credit.

(a) Subscription Charge Options:

Fixed Options

1. Capacity Charge per Subscribed kW **\$7.32**

2. Low Income Capacity Charge per Subscribed kW **\$7.18**

Volumetric Option

3. Energy Charge per Subscribed Energy **\$0.03855**

(b) Subscription Credit:

MISO Market Settlement Rate per Subscribed Energy **Varies**

B. In no month will a Customer's monthly bill be less than the otherwise applicable minimum. In the event that the Customer's bill would result in the otherwise applicable minimum, any credit amount not applied in the current billing month will be carried forward to the following billing month.

(5) RENEWABLE ENERGY CREDITS (RECs)

The Company shall retire Renewable Energy Credits ("RECs") associated with the Customer's Subscribed Energy on the Customer's behalf. Upon request of the Customer, the Company will transfer the RECs associated with subscriptions of non-residential Customers to an account held by such Customer as an alternative to the Company retiring RECs on such Customer's behalf, so long as the Customer agrees to retire the RECs on its own behalf and not transfer them to a third party.

(6) DEFINITIONS

Renewable Resource Capacity: Capacity associated with Cleco's Renewable Resource(s), as identified in Attachment A hereto.

Renewable Resource(s): The renewable resources designated by the Company and approved by the LPSC to supply renewable energy for this GO CLECO Rider, as identified in Attachment A hereto.

Low-Income Residential Customer: A Low-Income Residential Customer is a Customer who meets applicable eligibility requirements to qualify for LIHEAP at the time the Customer is enrolled in this program.

MISO Market Settlement Rate: Per kWh rate derived from monthly weighted average locational marginal prices ("LMPs") for Cleco Power load zone (CLEC.CLEC) based on the output of the Renewable Resource(s) in the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. ("MISO") energy markets. Application for billing purposes will be on a two-month lag.

Monthly Renewable Resource kWh Output: Amount of kWh generated each calendar month by Cleco's Renewable Resource(s). Application for billing purposes will be on a two-month lag.

Subscribed Energy: The monthly energy associated with the Customer's contracted Subscribed kW and calculated based on the following formula: [(Customer's Subscribed kW / Renewable Resource Capacity) x Monthly Renewable Resource kWh Output]. Application for billing purposes will be on a two-month lag.

(7) SERVICE PERIOD

The initial term of a subscription agreement under this GO CLECO Rider shall be for a minimum of a one-year period, beginning on the execution date of the subscription agreement and ending on the June 30 that is at least one year after the execution date. The initial term of the subscription agreement shall automatically be extended for a period of one year beginning on July 1 and shall thereafter automatically be extended for successive periods of one year beginning each subsequent July 1 until terminated by written notice given by one party to the other not more than six months nor less than two months prior to the expiration of the initial term or an extension term thereof.

If Customer discontinues service with Cleco, the subscription agreement under this GO CLECO Rider will be terminated except if (1) the Customer is relocating within the Cleco service area, and (2) initiates service at a new location at the time of discontinuing the original service, in which event then Customer may opt to transfer their subscription agreement to the new account for service.

If Customer is no longer in good standing with the Cleco due to non-payment, Cleco reserves the right to terminate Customer's subscription agreement. A customer whose subscription agreement has been terminated will not be eligible for reinstatement for the remainder of the term of the subscription agreement and must pay all sums outstanding before the customer can enter into a new subscription agreement. When a subscription agreement is terminated, the terminated customer's subscribed kW will be available to all other customers for subscription.

(8) TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Service under this GO CLECO Rider is subject to the Company's Standard Terms and Conditions for Electric Service and to all other rate schedules of the Company on file with the LPSC and applicable to service hereunder, as specified in the subscription agreement between the Company and Customer, or otherwise, including, but not limited to applicable rate schedules and adjustment clauses.

(9) GROSS MONTHLY BILL AND PAYMENT

The net monthly bill is due and payable each month. The gross monthly bill and payment provisions will be those set forth in Customer's standard rate schedule for electric service or in Customer's Agreement for Electric Service or site-specific agreement, as applicable.

(10) **OTHER PROVISIONS**

Provisions, prices, billings, and regulations of Cleco's other rate schedules and riders are not modified by any provisions of, or the service offered in, this GO CLECO Rider.

ATTACHMENT A

Renewable Resources: Capacity and Allocation

The initial total "Renewable Resource Capacity" is 240 MW. The Renewable Resource Capacity may be expanded from time-to-time should Cleco add further renewable resources to Cleco's resource portfolio. The initial "Renewable Resource" means the First Amended and Restated Power Purchase Agreement, between Cleco Power LLC, Buyer, and Dolet Hills Solar, LLC, Seller, dated as of February 23, 2024, as amended by the Second Amendment to Power Purchase Agreement between Cleco Power LLC, Buyer and Dolet Hills Solar, LLC, Seller, dated as of March 7, 2024. Subscriptions to the Renewable Resource Capacity shall be allocated among the customer classes in accordance with Section 1 of this GO CLECO Rider as follows:
